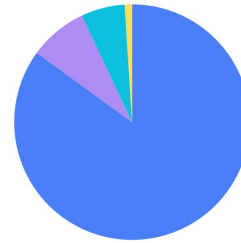

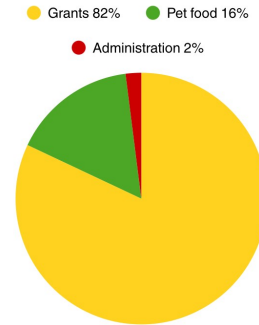

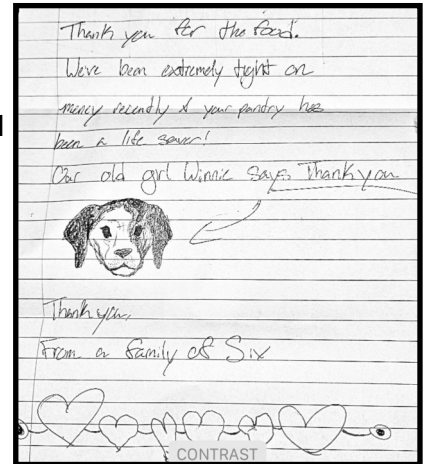


Heart2Heart Pet Food Pantries (3)
